

Proposed changes to be made to the Constitution at the
Parish AGM Friday, 18 June 2010 at 7.30pm

Re 5.5:-

For continuity of the PPC it is desirable that terms of office are staggered so that not more than three members of the PPC retire annually.

Proposed amendment from three to two would read:-

“For continuity of the PPC it is desirable that terms of office are staggered so that not more than two members of the PPC retire annually.”

Re 6.2.1:-

The second in the ballot for Chairman at the first meeting of the PPC following the AGM automatically becomes the Vice Chairman.

For purposes of continuity, propose:-

“The current Chairperson becomes Vice Chairman for the following year.”

Re 8.8.1:-

Each year in September each committee should present budgets or expected outgoings which are to be funded by the parish to the Parish Finance Committee for approval, covering the period 1 January to 31 December of the following year;

As it has been agreed that the committees do not require a budget – a preferred modus operandi is to submit a letter from each committee declaring that they do not envisage spending above £250 during the year, accordingly propose:-

“Each year in September each committee should submit a letter to the Parish Finance Committee for approval, covering the period 1 January to 31 December of the following year, declaring that it was not envisaged that reimbursement would be sought from the parish which would exceed £250.”

Finally, to comply with the agreement made last year that the title of this meeting would be Parish AGM, proposed change to all references to AGM in the Constitution document to read ***Parish AGM***.
