 - Shared cost of construction £950k;
 - Anticipated future sale of old Parish Centre (OPC) £725k;
 - Fund-raising required £225k
 - Planned Giving Campaign starts 20.6.09 to boost Parish income
 - Agreed bridging loan interest (at Bank of England base rate) to be covered from fund-raising
 - Parish funds already used for £100k NPC expenditure
 - Diocese response awaited on request to cap assessment on income;
- Purchase of a Square Metre raised £2,400 but agreed needed further push;
- Forthcoming Hog Roast (12/7), concert (25/7), Talents (ongoing);
